TOPIC :" A Study on impact of Vocational Education on Skill Development of Secondary Schools. "

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1. ABSTRACT :

Education to complement the overall development of the individual is the primary responsibility of the Government & Community. Government to provide vocational education with practical, free, and reasonable access to learning opportunities in the pursuit of its various goals.Vocational education is a proficient, competent, skilled learning program with active earning potential.Skill development is an inspiration for career education.The primary responsibility of the school system should be the onerous responsibility of creating a wide range of career options for high school-level learners with professional skills development.

2. OBJECTIVES OF THE STUDY :

- Analyzes the use of modern equipment and equipment in current training.

3. METHODOLOGY :

i) **SAMPLE** : A simple random sampling or systematic sampling method is adopted. A predetermined number of observations are taken from a larger population.

ii) TOOLS :Information was collected through questionnaires from headmasters, teachers and students. Necessary information has been obtained orally and in writing from other authorities as well.

iv) DATA ANALYSES :Data collected using the tools was analysed using Statisticsl methodology. Used descriptive analysis and percentage analysis.

4. FINDINGS OF THE STUDY :

- All the respondants have opied that conducting vocational education programs have enhanced skills among the children in schools who have undergone Vocational Traning Programme.
- Many respondents have told that Vocational Education is very useful in shaping the students to build their careers.
- Vocational Education has to be based on the Practical Experience so that the same may be implemented among the student community after the school.
- Proper councelling and guidance is given to the students in choosing their career.
- Only some schools have made an agreement with occupational organisations. This will not only help the studets to gain the practical knowledge but also helps in making their career choice and establishing the self-employment.

- Many problems are faced by the Teachers as well student mainly the basic facilities like modern machinary, equipments etc. Provide the basic necessities so the teaching learning to happen in proper way.
- Most of the respondents have opied that many of the students have been successful implementing their skills to build their careers. They have successfully established their own tradings / set-ups.
